**Q: IS THERE PARKING AVAILABLE?**

A: The best place to park will be the Renaissance Parking Garage on Columbus Ave. From 6:00pm on Friday to 11:00pm on Sunday it is 6\$ for up to 24 hours. There is some street parking available as well but be sure to read signs about parking restrictions

**Q: WHAT ARE THE PLANS FOR MEALS?**

A: On Saturday and Sunday we will provide breakfast and lunch. So dinner on all nights will not be provided. There are plenty of places around campus to eat or to order delivery.

**Q: WHAT SOFTWARE WILL YOU HAVE AVAILABLE?**

A: The lab machines we plan on using can dual boot to Mac or Windows. We have the full Adobe Suite as well as other asset creation programs for creating 3D models and sound. We also have Panda 3D and Unity installed. We may be able to install other programs during the event if you let us know on Friday.

A: If you plan on bringing a desktop please also bring a monitor, but we should have space to set it up. Everyone is welcome to bring their own laptop as well.
